

Foundations for Learning

Upgrading Courses

Offered in an “anytime online” delivery format, these courses help learners prepare for the workforce, post-secondary entrance or further academic upgrading.

GED Preparation Foundations (GEDP 1521) – learn strategies to prepare for writing the GED exam. Students focus on developing and improving their writing, reading, science, social studies and math skills. Successful learners progress to *High School Prep Math Foundations* and English 10-1 or 10-2.

Pre-Trades Math and Science Preparation Foundations (MATH 1521) – focus on developing the math and science skills needed to pass the apprenticeship exam.

Prep for Practical Nurse Foundations (MATH 1524) – successful completion gives students the math prerequisite needed for entry into the Practical Nurse program at NorQuest.

Pre-Algebra Foundations (Math 1522) – develop the math skills needed for algebra-based courses. Topics include whole numbers, decimals, fractions, integers, ratios, proportions, measurement and an introduction to algebra. Successful learners progress to *Pre-Trades Math and Science Preparation Foundations*, *GED Preparation Foundations* or *High School Prep Math Foundations*.

High School Prep Math Foundations (Math 1523) – study basic algebra skills required for high school math courses. Topics include number systems, rational numbers, algebraic expressions and equations, problem solving, exponent laws, geometry and measurement. Successful learners progress to Math 10C.

Language Training Courses:

Offered in a “real-time online” format, these courses help English language learners acquire reading and writing skills.

ESL Intermediate Listening and Speaking Foundations (ESLS 1521) – a flexible learning format that supports English language learners to improve their listening and speaking skills. Intermediate-level grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation strategies will be taught.

ESL Intermediate Reading and Writing Foundations (ESLW 1521) – a flexible learning format that supports English language learners to improve their reading and writing skills. Intermediate-level grammar and vocabulary will be taught.
