

Foundations for Learning

A partnership opportunity between NorQuest College and CALPs

- NorQuest College provides the courses and instructors for online learning opportunities.
- CALPs advertise this program and courses in their community, assist learners with the registration process if necessary, and provide up to 30 hours of tutorial service to the learner free of charge

CALPs can receive up to \$900 per learner to cover administrative and tutor costs. The CALP also provides invigilation services for Final Exams to the learner at no cost.

When the student registers with a CALP, the CALP submits an invoice to NorQuest College (Kara Mothersell) for \$450. If the learner is still registered in the course after 4 weeks, the CALP submits another invoice for \$450 to the college.

Invoices and tutor tracking forms should be submitted together, as this shows there is a tutor in place to support learners in the course. The invoice template and tutor tracking forms have example sheets to follow.

Learners may come to CALPs after they have registered in the course. Although learners may not access a tutor, they should be encouraged to do so, to support their success in the course they are taking.
